## Drop Off and Pick Up

Previously, there was an arrangement whereby parents who needed to drive to and from school were able be able to drop off and pick up older children (Year 3 and above) at the front of school on Tranby Lane, next to the wooden gate near the astro-turf.

Parents are still able to do this, however, there will not be anyone supervising. If you wish to drop off/pick up your child(ren), please do not park or wait in this area. In the morning, drop off your child and move away quickly afterwards. At the end of school, please do not arrive before 3.30pm; if your child is not waiting when you arrive, please drive around the block and come back for them.

# After School Collection Arrangements - Year 5

If Year 5 parents could meet the children on the big playground or at the school gate, to stop the small playground being congested, that would be very helpful.

## When Collecting Children In The Small Playground ...

When collecting your child(ren), would parents please not wait on the mobile classroom end of the small playground. Please wait near the playing field or at the other end of the

playground in order that the year 1, 2 and 5 children can get onto the playground easily and safely. Thank you.

## Eligibility for Pupil Premium/Free School Meals

Families in receipt of certain <u>state benefits</u> are eligible for Free School Meals, regardless of the child's age. This eligibility for Free School Meals also determines whether the school itself receives the Government's <u>'Pupil Premium' grant</u>, so it is extremely beneficial to the school to be aware of your child's eligibility, <u>even during Reception and Key Stage 1 years</u>.

Your child may be eligible for free school meals if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- · the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax
  Credit
- Universal Credit

If you consider that your child MAY be eligible for free school meals in relation to the state benefits which you receive, please complete this online form BEFORE OCTOBER 2021.

If you receive confirmation that your child is eligible for free school meals, we should be very grateful if you would inform the School Office in strictest confidence. Thank you very much.
