Dear Parent/Carer of Reception children

We are looking forward to meeting you and your child this week for their half-day visits to their new class. This week, your child will attend one morning and one afternoon session; you will have previously been sent the dates that your child will attend.

On these dates, you can enter the school grounds in the usual way, either through the gate on Tranby Lane or through the gate at the back of the school, behind the Village Hall. The timings for the morning are from 9.30-11.30 am and for the afternoon from 1.30-3.30 pm. At these times, the gates will be open and you can walk your child around to the Reception play area on the small playground (there will be staff around you to show you the way if you are unsure). The staff will meet you and your child on the playground and you will leave them for the session.

Children should wear uniform on these days and should bring a water bottle, sun hat and wear sun cream. Children will not need to bring their PE kit into school but <u>should come to school wearing it on their PE day</u>, (Thursday for RCM and Friday for RHM), <u>starting from week commencing 13th September</u>.

From Monday 13th September, your child will start full days. Your child will be able to enter the classroom between 8.45 and 8.55 am and can be picked up at the end of the day from the same place at 3.30 pm.

Over the next week, you will be sent information about our electronic payment system, ParentPay, however, school lunches for your child are free so you will not need this just yet.

There will be a meeting, on Monday 20th September at 6.00 pm in the Large Hall at school, for any parents that wish to attend (children do not need to attend this meeting). In the meeting, we will talk about some of the things you may wish to know and answer any questions you may have. You do not need to book a place, please just come to the main entrance on Tranby Lane before 6.00 pm to be let into the school.
