Year 4 Residential Visit to Cranedale Centre, Kirby Grindalythe, Malton
Thursday 31st March to Friday 1st April 2022 - Deposit £50.00 - Payable Online

Next year, we are organising a residential visit for the children in Year 4. This will give the children the opportunity to experience staying away from home for just one night and thus provide them with the many fantastic opportunities that cannot be experienced in school. Further details will be discussed at the upcoming Meet and Greet meeting.

The visit will be to the Cranedale Centre near Sledmere. Whilst away the children will undertake projects such as ECO challenges, learning about wildlife, taking part in orienteering activities, creating some 'Wild Art' and using teamwork skills to complete a low ropes assault course. The visit is optional and will take place during the summer term, from Thursday 31st March to Friday 1st April 2022.

The approximate cost of the visit (depending on numbers) will be £140.00; this includes all meals and transportation. To secure your booking, should your child wish to take part in the visit, a deposit of £50.00 will need to be paid by Monday 4<sup>th</sup> October 2021 via ParentPay, where you are also able to give your consent for your child to take part in this visit. Should you require a paper consent form, please ask at the School Office. The balance will be confirmed nearer the time and may be paid online using ParentPay in instalments, up until the final payment deadline of Friday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

As we are sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of his or her inability to pay.
