#### Suggested Kit List

The suggested kit list can include what the children are wearing to travel in:

- 3 long-sleeved T-shirts
- 3 sweatshirts / fleece tops
- 3 pairs of trousers (in case they get wet; but not jeans, please)
- 1 pair of shorts
- 3 sets of underwear
- 3 pairs of socks
- 1 pair of trainers (indoor use)
- 1 pair of outdoor shoes/boots
- 1 pair of wellington boots \*
- 1 warm, waterproof coat/jacket (with hood)
- 1 pair of waterproof trousers \*
- 1 towel
- 1 warm hat / sun hat
- 1 set of nightwear
- 1 bag of toiletries
- · gloves and scarf
- day rucksack (to carry water bottle and waterproofs around)
- sun protection
- a named water bottle
- a bin bag to bring back wet or muddy items

Please ensure that wherever possible items are <u>clearly named</u>. Owing to the nature of some of the activities, clothing may get dirty or wet. Please do not send any expensive items of clothing.

Pupils may take a book, magazine or cards to play with during free time but NO ELECTRONIC GAMES, PHONES or TORCHES.

There is a shop on site which sells some small stationery items. £5 may be brought to spend on the Thursday evening.

<sup>\*</sup> The Centre has a supply of wellies, waterproof coats and waterproof trousers but if children have their own it is very useful if they bring them along.

Please pack items in as small a bag as possible - luggage space is limited on the coach. The bag must have a clear luggage label.

Swanland staff will take items such as balls etc to play with during free time.

#### Medication

- Please fill in and return the <u>Medical and Pupil Information Form</u> (attached) to your child's class teacher <u>by 11<sup>th</sup> March 2022.</u>
- Any medicines should be handed to Mrs Carney on Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> March with labels and details of what should be taken and when. If this is not possible, they should be handed to her on the Thursday morning. Children with asthma should carry their own inhalers.
- Those requiring travel sickness pills should take these before travelling and hand the ones for the return journey to Mrs Carney.
