Confirmation of Final Cost and Outstanding Balance



As you may remember, the Year 4 children, along with their class teachers, invested significant time and efforts during Year 4 on their Primary Enterprise Craft Project 2019 in order to subsidise their school trip to London which unfortunately could not take place. As a consequence, the profit from this project will subsidise this residential trip to Whitby, so we can now confirm that the total cost for the Year 6 residential visit to Whitby is £151.26, which includes all meals and transportation. A full itinerary and activity list will be sent nearer the time.

The non-refundable deposit of £50.00 has already been paid.

The balance of £101.26 is now due and may be paid online using ParentPay. You may pay in instalments up until the deadline of Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> March. ParentPay will show your reducing balance after each payment. Please note, should you decide not to send your child once this payment has been made, this payment is non-refundable.

We are aware that this is a short payment time frame. In view of this, please contact the School Office if you would like to speak confidentially regarding the possibility of a payment plan.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and therefore could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of his or her inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
