Vacancy: Senior Catering Assistant — DEADLINE: MONDAY 4th April 2022 at 12.00 pm We currently have a vacancy for a Senior Catering Assistant within our school kitchen, working Monday to Friday from 8.00 am to 2.45 pm (with half-an-hour for lunch), term-time only. The role is available from Monday 25th April 2022 or as soon as possible thereafter.

In this role, the successful applicant would support the Cook in Charge in the day-to-day running and operation of the school kitchen at Swanland Primary School, working as part of a team of six, where approximately 330 meals are prepared, cooked and served each day at Swanland and approximately 40 meals are transported to Dunswell Academy. This position would suit an established caterer with experience of working in a large-scale catering environment and, ideally, with some previous experience of working in school catering.
