## COVID-19 Update

As we are all aware, COVID-19 is still circulating and causing severe illness for a minority of our population. We have a collective responsibility to work together to protect those most vulnerable, whilst also protecting face-to-face education for our children and young people.

This means educational establishments still need to continue with control measures. We will do this by:

- 1. Ensuring good hygiene for everyone (hand hygiene & respiratory hygiene)
- 2. Maintaining appropriate cleaning regimes
- 3. Keeping occupied spaces well-ventilated
- 4. Following public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of COVID-19

From 24<sup>th</sup> February 2022, the legal requirement to self-isolate following a positive test has been removed. However, both adults and children who test positive are advised to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 days. On the  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  day, if negative test results are returned, the individual can cease staying at home and return to normal activity (ie return to school). However, if they do not return negative test results on the  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  day, they are strongly advised to continue to stay at home until they have returned two negative results. Regardless of test results, they can return to school on the  $11^{th}$  day.



#### Home Learning

Should your child need to isolate because of a positive COVID-19 test result yet is well enough to complete schoolwork, please contact your child's class teacher on SeeSaw or Tapestry where they will provide work to complete through the website. On the whole, lessons will be able to be completed independently at home, however, if you or your child requires any support, please ask the class teacher and they will get in touch.

## Reminder of School's Food Policy - No Nuts/Peanut Butter or Chocolate Products


In order to protect the growing number of children with allergies to nuts we have, for some years, had a whole school policy which protects children from being exposed to "nutty" products in school. PLEASE
