**Jubilee Sponsored Walk and Afternoon Tea 2022 – Friday 27th May 2022**

This year our Jubilee Sponsored Walk and Afternoon Tea will take place on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May during school time. Thank you to those who have already returned sponsorship forms. If you need another copy, please ask at the School Office.

When you have helped your child to complete their sponsorship form, please return it to your child's teacher **on or before Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May**. The signed form will be returned to your child immediately after the walk so they can bring it back in with the money they have raised. *Please do not bring in any money before the Sponsored Walk – thank you.*

Don't forget it will be a non-uniform day that day and children will be able to wear red, white and blue clothing! Please ensure your child also has comfy shoes, a water bottle, sun protection, a sun hat and a lightweight shower-proof coat.

If you would like to walk with us, please meet outside the front of School on Tranby Lane – you will then be 'collected' as your child's class leaves the school. Siblings may walk together if a parent or carer is present; please fill in the online form overleaf.

This year we are fundraising for the School and are hoping to raise money for the development of a Well-being and Sensory Room. The class with the most sponsors returned will win an afternoon at the playing field with their class! All sponsored children will receive a Spring Walk sticker for their Praise and Award card.

At the end of the walk, adults will be invited to stay (no dogs on school site) for an Afternoon Tea picnic (you may wish to bring a rug/blanket). Children will briefly return to their cloakrooms to collect their bags and go to the toilet before meeting their adults on the school field. Children will be provided with a snack and a drink by School and PTA, but you may bring your own too. Any child who does not have an adult

attending the Afternoon Tea, will be supervised by staff until the end of the school day and handed over in the usual manner at 3.20 pm.

The toilets at the main entrance will be available for adults to use upon return from the walk if required. Gates will be locked until 3.05 pm, when parents may take their child home.

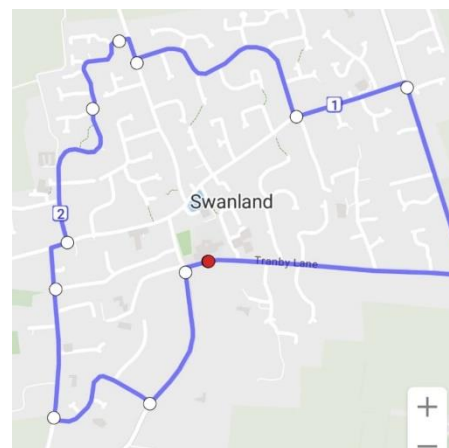

### Walking Routes

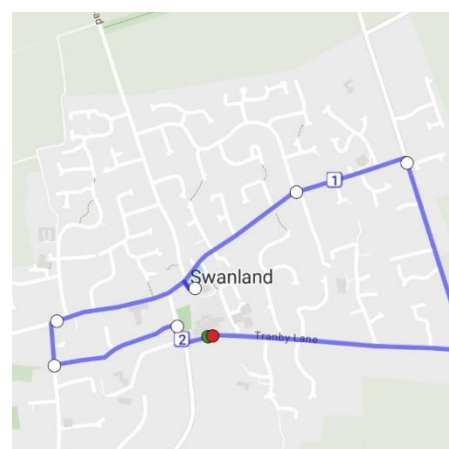
#### Years 3-5

- Exit the front of School and turn left down Tranby Lane
- Turn left down Greenstiles Lane
- Turn left down Main Street
- Turn right up Northfield
- Turn right onto Dale Road
- Turn left onto Westerdale
- Onto Sykes Close/Westfield Lane
- Cross onto West Leys Road
- Left onto West Leys Park
- Left onto Kemp Road
- Right onto Tranby Lane and back to School



#### Years 1-2

- Exit the front of School and turn left down Tranby Lane
- Turn left down Greenstiles Lane
- Turn left down Main Street
- All the way down Main Street onto West End
- Left onto West Leys Road
- Left onto Manor Road
- Across onto Tranby Lane and back to School



#### Reception (NB No dogs are allowed at the Park)

- The children will turn right out of School onto Tranby Lane
- Across onto Manor Road
- To Swanland Park
- Laps of Swanland Park before returning back to School
