My name is Dan Ward and I have worked as a teacher in Hull and East-Riding schools since 2009. I am offering in-school tuition sessions to help to boost children's progress in the following areas: Maths, Reading/Comprehension, SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar) and Writing.
