Parent Governor Vacancy

Change to School Dinner Menu for Census Day - Thursday 6th October 2022

Next Thursday is national Census Day for all primary schools, where (amongst other key figures) the number of Key Stage 1 children staying for school dinners that day is recorded. This figure (along with the same figure recorded on the January 2023 Census Day) then determines how much Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) grant the School receives. This UIFSM grant is paid to the School to cover the cost of the provision of free school meals for our children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and is paid at the rate of £2.41 per day, throughout the school year, for every child that stays for a meal on those October and January census days (a total of £444.60 per eligible child).

So, with this in mind, we are tweaking the menu next week to encourage as many children as possible to stay for a hot school meal on Thursday. Please see the Harvest Festival flyer showing the menu for the day — Toad in the Hole, Mashed Potato, Peas, Carrots and Gravy with Apple Crumble for dessert!

May we please ask you to encourage your EYFS/KS1 child to stay for a hot meal that day or to try a hot school meal for the first time, if they have not already done so! Any additional income is very important for the School, so we do hope you can help. Thank you.

Harvest Festival - Wednesday 12th October 2022

On Wednesday 12th October 2022, the children will be visiting Christ Church, Swanland, for a Harvest Festival celebration. In the lead up to the Harvest Festival, Christ Church are collecting food for Hull Foodbank (Trussell Trust). Hull Foodbank only works with non-perishable food items (tinned and dried goods), which do not spoil or decay. They have plenty of Beans and Pasta but the following types of food are urgently needed:
