Year 5 - Evacuee Day - Thursday 13th October 2022



On Thursday 13th October 2022, the Year 5 children are invited to spend the school day <u>dressed as evacuees</u>. This will be part of the Year 5 Impact of War topic, as we look at how ordinary people at home were affected by the war. In an effort to be authentic, please keep your child's costume simple, for example a plain blouse/shirt with plain skirt/trousers will be fine.

Your child will also be building a mini <u>Anderson Shelter</u> (A4 size). They will be decorating the shelter in context with the period. If you have any resources that they may use, please send them with your child on the day.

The children do not need to bring any of their usual equipment to school, so no bags, pencil cases, books etc needed. They can bring a small teddy, a small case, or a gas mask box (small cardboard box) if they would like to – anything an evacuee may have travelled with.
