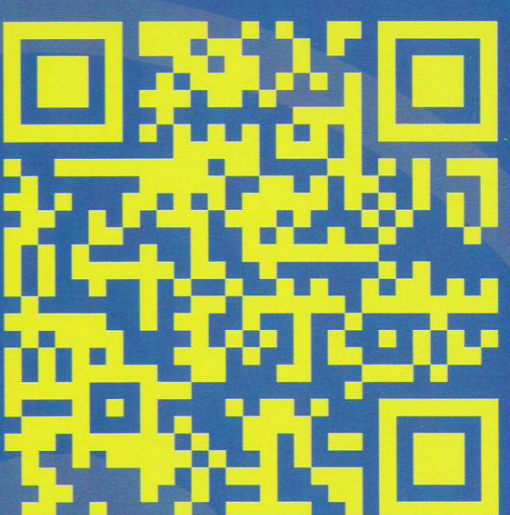


SEND East Riding LOCAL OFFER

The Local Offer provides information about education, health and care for children and young people with SEND, their parents and carers, professionals and service providers.

Education

Information about education providers (i.e. schools, colleges and nurseries), transport, early years support, post-16 provision, medical conditions at school, educational psychology service, education inclusion service, Sensory and Physical Teaching Service (SaPTS), Behaviour Support Team (BST) and Education, Health and Care (EHC) plans.

Leisure

Information about leisure activities, specifically aimed at supporting those with SEND, including music and the arts, leisure centres, cinemas, theatres, libraries, sport and countryside events. There is also information available regarding youth groups and commissioned services.

Health

Information about health services including children's nursing, support for those with learning disabilities, neurodiversity services, continuing care, specialist dental services, speech and language therapy services and emotional and mental health support.

Money Matters

Information about financial support specifically for individuals with SEND and also those who care for them, including personal budgets and direct payments, personal transport budgets, travel passes, discount cards, charities and grants, and information regarding benefit eligibility.

Care and Support

Information about childcare and children's centres. Support from services including the 0-25 SEND Team, Families Information Service Hub (FISH), Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Information, Advice and Support Service (SENDIASS), East Yorkshire Parent Carer Forum (EYPCF) and The Young Leaders of East Riding (T.Y.L.E.R.).

Adulthood

Information about moving into adulthood including services provided by Futures+, Preparing for Adulthood (PFA), independent living, education, employment and training opportunities, and community inclusion.
