Develop	To grow bigger and become stronger
offspring	The child of an animal
Live young	Offspring that has not hatched from an egg
Hatchling	A young animal that has recently hatched from an egg
Larvae	A young of certain animals that make physical changes before they become an adult.
Survive	To continue to live or exist
Oxygen	A colourless gas that animals breathe in.
Carbon Dioxide	A colourless gas that animals breathe out.
adult	A fully grown animal or plant
Life cycle	The changes living things go through to become an adult
young	Offspring that has not reached adulthood
human	A child or adult, we are one.

Some animals give birth to **live young**.



Some animals lay eggs which the **young** hatch from.



Both of these types of **young** then **develop** into **adults**.

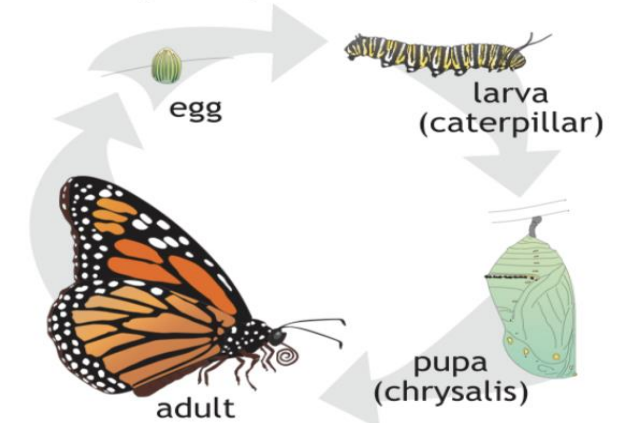
All young animals change as they go through the different stages of their life cycle and grow into adults

Basic needs of survival

Water	Over half of a human body is made up of water. It is an important part of survival
Food	Something that living things eat to keep them alive. It gives them energy and helps them grow
Air	A living thing takes in oxygen from the air and gives out carbon dioxide.
Shelter	People and animals use shelter to protect themselves from their surroundings, to keep them safe
