# King Charles III Coronation Celebrations at Swanland School

#### **PICNIC**

On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May, to celebrate the Coronation, we will be holding a full school picnic (weather permitting) on the school field, starting at 2.15 pm until the end of the school day. Children may come wearing red, white and blue clothing for the day. Parents/carers are invited to attend the picnic and children may sit with their visiting adult(s). Any children who do not have an adult visiting will be able to sit with the school adults. Children can bring food items with them in the morning or their adult(s) may bring it with them at 2.15 pm. For this event, parents/carers should enter the school site via the back gate near the Pond only, this is to allow us to monitor the gate for safeguarding reasons. Class staff will supervise the children until their adult(s) arrives to collect them for their picnic. The school gate will close at 2.30 pm and reopen again at 3.10 pm for home time.

#### A GIFT FROM THE PTA

On the day, all the children will receive a special commemorative Coronation gift from the PTA.

#### MAKING A SWAN DECORATION

Every child and adult in the school will be designing a special wooden swan, which we will display on the school hedge on Tranby Lane for the weekend of the Coronation. To link in with King Charles III's environmental work, we will ask the children to design their Royal swan with their own environmental hope and message for the future. We would also like to encourage this to be a wider community project, so will be selling the wooden swans from the School Office so that family, friends and Swanland neighbours can add their own environmental hopes by designing and adding a swan.

### **TREE PLANTING**

Again, to link in with King Charles III's interest in the environment, will be planting a special blossom tree in the garden area at the front of school during May. A special draw will be made to choose the children who will take part in the tree planting.

### **'SWAN' TREASURE HUNT**

The school has liaised with Swanland Heritage Centre to create a 'Swan' treasure hunt around the village! There will be wooden swans hidden around the village – to find the swans you will need to follow the Heritage Trail! On the Monday of the Coronation weekend (10.00 am until 4.00 pm), there will be a map and an answer sheet which can be found at the Heritage Centre, near the pond. Follow the map and locate the swans, then find the class name or name linked with the school on the back of the swan and write the name that you find on your answer sheet. Once the trail has been completed, hand in your answer sheet at the Heritage Centre and you will be rewarded with a small prize! All answer sheets collected will also be sent back into school for a grand prize draw, funded by the PTA, on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May.
