<u>Summer Sponsored Colour Run – 25th May 2023</u>



This year, instead of a Sponsored Walk, we will be holding a Sponsored Colour Run on the school field on Thursday 25th May 2023 (the last day of half-term). The colour run will be held to raise money for school resources including books and IT equipment. If you are not sure what a Colour Run is or what you will need to do, more information is provided below.

Colour Runs are a fun run with a difference! During the Colour Run, the children will be running laps of a specially laid out track on the school field. At special stations, colourful powder will be thrown in the air as children run through. The colour powder we use is safe for everyone to use – <u>click here</u> to see the Safety and Cleaning Information Overview.

The children will take part in the Colour Run at various times, with their class, throughout the afternoon. They will get changed into their colour run clothing after lunch and will travel home in the clothes they have run in.

- Children must wear glasses or goggles during the race so please send them with something they can wear on their eyes during the race.
- The colour powder should wash out of clothing but can stain. Please send your child with clothes and trainers that you do not mind getting stained. We recommend participants wear a plain white t-shirt to get the full effect of the Colour Run!
- After the race, children will be asked to shake and pat off as much powder as possible, but you may wish to bring a towel or sheet for them to sit on if you are travelling home by car.
- The powder will wash out of hair. Rinse your child's hair with cold water first to remove as much as possible, then wash using a good quality shampoo. Alternatively, children can wear a hat or fun wig!

Over the page is a Consent Form. Please fill it in and return it to your child's class teacher <u>before Friday</u> 5^{th} May 2023. Without a returned Consent Form, your child will be unable to take part. Alternative arrangements will be made for any children not taking part in the Colour Run.

Also, please find overleaf a Sponsorship Form (which is also available to print from the School's website). When you have helped your child complete their Sponsorship Form, please return it to your child's teacher on or before Thursday 25th May, for their <u>anticipated sum</u> to be recorded before the event (<u>please do not</u> <u>send any money at this stage</u>).

Unfortunately, we are unable to invite parents to come and watch this event owing to space restrictions, but we will take photos to share with you!
