REMINDER: King Charles III Coronation Picnic - TOMORROW, Friday 5th May 2023

To celebrate the Coronation, tomorrow (Friday 5th May) we will be holding a full school picnic (weather permitting) on the school field, starting at 2.15 pm until the end of the school day. Children may come wearing red, white and blue clothing for the day. Parents/carers are invited to attend the picnic and children may sit with their visiting adult(s). Any children who do not have an adult visiting will be able to sit with the school adults. Children can either bring food items with them in the morning or their adult(s) may bring them at 2.15 pm. For this event, parents/carers should enter the school site via the back gate near the Pond only, this is to allow us to monitor the gate for safeguarding reasons. Class staff will supervise the children until their adult(s) arrives to collect them for their picnic. The school gate will close at 2.30 pm and reopen again at 3.10 pm for home time.

Please note that at the time of writing this letter, the weather forecast is for thundery showers on Friday afternoon. We will check the forecast again in the morning and let you know by 10.00 am whether the picnic has to be cancelled. If it does, the children who have brought food in, will bring it home at the end of the day.

We currently have a vacancy for a part-time Catering Assistant in our school kitchen, working Monday to Friday for 13.75 hours per week, term-time only plus 4 cleaning days/year in the school holidays – the post is available to start as soon as possible. The role is paid at NJC SCP 2 (ie £20,441 pa pro rata or £10.60/hour).

Working as part of a team of six, the successful applicant would be helping to prepare and serve food and drink to children and adults within the school, maintaining excellent safety, cleanliness and hygiene standards. The position is both busy and varied and, although previous experience would be desirable, it is not essential. (Please be aware, this is a physical role involving standing, bending and lifting and applicants will need to be physically able to cope with these duties.)
