Dear Parent/Carer (Year 2)



Year 2 – Visit to Welton Waters – Thursday 29th June 2023

It is proposed that the Year 2 pupils will visit Welton Waters on Thursday 29th June 2023. The children will travel by coach, and it will be a half-day visit per class.

- Class 2EE/SP will visit in the morning, departing school at 8.50 am and returning at 1.10 pm – NB please ensure your child arrives at school on time.
- Class 2JP will visit in the afternoon, departing school at 11.40 am and returning at 3.50 pm – NB please note the children will be a little late returning to school, but should be collected in the usual way from the KS1 playground.

The activities at Welton Waters will be run by suitably qualified instructors. The children will be taking part in team games and water activities. For the water-based activities the children will wear buoyancy aids.

On the day, the children should arrive at school wearing outdoor clothing, including a waterproof jacket. Everyone will need swimwear, a sun-hat, a towel and an OLD pair of trainers or sandals which can get wet (NB no crocs or flip-flops as they are dangerous). Please note that during the water activities footwear will get wet and dirty so do not forget to bring dry shoes/socks to travel home in. Everything else will be provided (ie wetsuits, helmets etc). All children will need to have sun cream applied at home in the morning.

We offer the option of a free packed lunch on school trip days to those children who are eligible for Universal Infant Free School Meals (EYFS and KS1). A school packed lunch consists of a sandwich on brown bread with sunflower spread, a piece of fruit, a biscuit and a bottle of still water. This is not compulsory; your child may bring their own packed lunch if you prefer (no glass bottles please). To ensure we are aware of all requests for packed lunches on the day, may we please request that all parents complete this link (even if you do not require a school packed lunch) by Friday 9th June 2023 at the latest – thank you.

However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay.
