### Building Work Update

As you are aware, we are progressing with our building works on the Key Stage 1 playground, however, the builders have now had to close off access across this playground. Please see below the latest Drop-Off and Collection procedures:

### Drop-Off (AM)

<u>Children in Years 3, 4 and 6</u> can be dropped off at 8.45 am as usual on the Key Stage 2 playground and will line up in their classes to go into school.

Children in Years 1, 2 and 5 should also be dropped off on the Key Stage 2 playground with Years 3, 4 and 6. At 8 .45 am a whistle will be blown and the children will line up to be brought in and walked through school to their classrooms. (Yesterday afternoon the children were shown where to line up and we will help them on the first morning to find their correct place.)

Once the children have lined up, would you please move towards the playing field, away from the lines of children, so there is enough room for them on the playground — thank you.

Reception children should enter the school site from 8.40 am onwards via the gate on Tranby Lane closest to the corner of Tranby Lane and Kemp Road (near the astroturf) and dropped off at their classroom via the Reception play area. There is not a lot of waiting space, so please leave as soon as your child has entered the classroom. If possible, please avoid bringing prams/push chairs, although we appreciate this is not always possible.

NB: If you need to drop off a child in Reception and a sibling in another class, we recommend you drop off the older child in the Key Stage 2 playground and then make your way back to the Tranby Lane/Kemp Road entrance gate to drop off your child in Reception.

#### Collection (PM)

At the end of the day, we will dismiss all the children, as usual, from the Key Stage 2 playground/playing field. The children in Reception and Years 1,2 and 5 will walk through the school to also be dismissed from the Key Stage 2 playground.

As you will appreciate, these arrangements may need to change again but we will try to keep you fully informed via email/text. Please ensure that anyone else who may collect/drop off your child is made aware of these arrangements. Thank you.



## Colour Run - Thank you!


