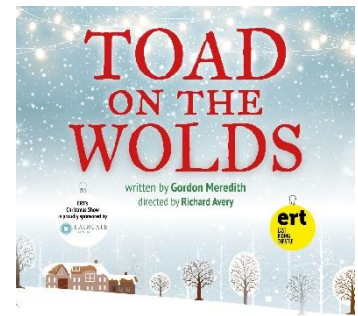

Year 6 – Visit to East Riding Theatre on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2023

On Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December we are taking Year 6 on a visit to East Riding Theatre in Beverley to see Toad on the Wolds. Toad's unfortunate antics have once again landed him in jail, and the timing couldn't be worse!
