<u>Absence</u>

VOMITING AND/OR DIARRHOEA – Children with these symptoms must be kept home for <u>48 hours</u> after their symptoms have gone. If symptoms persist or reoccur medical advice should be sought. This is to ensure there is no risk of contagion.

ALL ABSENCES – Please remember to call to the school before 9.15 am on the morning of each day's absence. By calling every day, we can be sure of your child's whereabouts and that they are safe.
