# First Aid - Head Bumps

When a child experiences a knock, bump or blow to their head, they are sent directly to the School Office where a First Aider assesses them, sits them down, comforts them and applies a cold compress to their head. A Head Bump Note will be completed; this is when we check how the injury happened, where it took place, check for any visible signs, behavioural signs, headache, feeling sick or dizzy, blurred vision. If we assess that the child requires no further treatment, the child will return to class. The Head Bump Note is sent back to the child's class to make the teacher aware (so they can continue monitoring the child) before being sent home with the child at the end of the day. Currently a telephone call is made by the School Office to the Parent/Carer following every Head Bump assessment. From Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2023, for MINOR head bumps the phone call will be replaced with a text, as follows:

[child's first name] has had a minor head bump today. We have given first aid and they have been sent back to class as we have no concerns. We will continue to monitor them. If symptoms worsen, we will, of course, telephone you to ensure you are aware of the situation.

However, if we assess a head bump to be serious or we are dealing with a vulnerable child, we will still telephone you to ensure you are aware of the situation.
