





Phonics

- In Year 1 we continue to use Little Wandle Phonics to build on the phonic knowledge that your children have gained during their Reception year.
- As we move into Phase 5 phonics the children learn about
- alternative graphemes for sounds (i.e. oi and oy),
- alternative pronunciations for the same grapheme (eg cow and snow)
- An introduction to spelling patterns.
- We will continue to consolidate the children's recognition and knowledge
 of the phonemes (sounds) learned last year and work on blending them for
 reading and segmenting for writing.

Phonics

 Each week, your child will bring home a sheet containing that week's phonics learning.

 Each child will have an individual sound book which will contain additional specific sounds for your child to practise. They will come home with them each day. Please make sure you keep these in their book bags and practice these sounds frequently.

Phonics Screening check

- Should take place in June 2024.
- Consists of 20 real words and 20 non-words.
- Takes place one to one, with your child's class teacher, in order to assess each child's decoding and blending abilities.

Literacy

- At first, most of our literacy objectives are covered within our afternoon topic sessions.
- During Autumn 1, our literacy aims will be:
- 1. To form letters correctly and keep writing on the line.
- 2. To use finger spaces, capital letters and full stops when writing sentences.
- 3. To apply the phonics learned in our daily phonics sessions.
- 4. To spell the tricky words from phases 2, 3 and 4 correctly

Literacy

- As the year progresses, we begin to have discrete literacy sessions to build skills in areas such as:
- 1. Using adjectives and conjunctions.
- 2. Using capital letters for names of people and places, days, months and personal pronoun 'I'.
- 3. To use prefix 'un' and suffixes 'ed' 'ing' 'er' 'est' where there is no change to the root word.
- 4. Exploring a wider variety of text types.

Maths

- Taught in discrete lessons.
- Fun, practical and hands-on
- Following White Rose Scheme
- Covering the areas of:
- 1. Number and Place Value,
- 2. Addition and Subtraction,
- 3. Multiplication and Division,
- 4. Fractions,
- 5. Position and Direction,
- 6. Shape, Space & Measures (including time & money).

Big Maths

Weekly Big Maths Beat That sessions to focus on quick recall of mental maths facts. The children are rewarded for beating their previous best score.
