Year 2 - Scooter Awareness Programme - January or February 2024 (date TBC)

Please find attached information regarding the <u>Year 2 Scooter Awareness Programme</u> run by the East Riding of Yorkshire Council. The training is due to take place in January or February 2024 (date TBC) within the school grounds.

The Scooter Awareness programme is designed to be one of the first steps in road safety for Year 2 children. The programme is also designed to complement the cycle training children receive in later year groups. The aim is that those children who have received the programme will then be able to scoot to school safely under the supervision of a responsible adult.

The training normally consists of a short road safety presentation in the classroom followed by a 30-minute session on the playground, where children will learn some safe scooting skills through fun activities.

The outdoor activity will promote control of the scooter and enhance skills. At the same time, the children will learn the importance of not straying too far from an adult and about basic courtesy when sharing a pavement with other pedestrians.

A scooter will be required for those children wishing to participate.

There will be a small charge of £2.00 per pupil, which is now available to pay on ParentPay, with a deadline of Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2024. If payment has not been received by the deadline, your child will be unable to participate in the training.
