# Drop off and Pick up arrangements from January 2024

From January 2024, the drop off and pick up arrangements for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will change. Years 3-6 will continue with the current arrangements in place.

In the morning, children and parents in all year groups should enter the playground through the gates next to the pond or on Tranby Lane, closest to Waller Grove. The gate next to the Astro turf will not be opened come January. Children in Reception will be able to enter the Reception play area via the gate nearest to RHM. Children in Years 1 and 2 will wait on the new KS1 playground and will line up when the whistle goes. The children have been shown where to line up. When the whistle is blown, please could we ask Parents to move to the back of the playground, next to the play apparatus in order to give space for lining up.



At the end of the day, parents can enter the school site in the same way as in the morning. Reception children can be picked up in the usual manner, however, please note from Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2024, the end of the school day will be at 3.20 pm for the Reception classes rather than at 3.10 pm. This is to fall in line with the rest of the school. Years 1 and 2 children will be brought out onto the new KS1 playground. Again, please can we ask that Parents stand at the back of the playground, near the playground apparatus, to give the classes space to dismiss.



#### Outdoor Play

We are trying to develop our play opportunities for the children of Swanland School, so in May we will be starting a programme called OPAL (Outdoor Play and Learning) which the PTA have kindly agreed to support with funding. However, in the meantime we are looking to purchase some storage and other useful items, therefore we have made an Amazon Wishlist. #### School Closure Procedures

Should the School close for any reason, for example, in the case of extreme bad weather, the following procedures will be followed:

If the School must close prior to the start of a school day:

- <u>Text:</u> We will text all parents (Emergency Contact No 1) to advise of the closure so please ensure you keep the School Office informed of any changes to your mobile telephone number.
- Website: There will be an update posted on the School website, www.swanlandschool.co.uk - under Key Info/The School Day and Notices.
- <u>Telephone</u>: There will be an emergency closure message on our telephone answer machine, directing parents to the website.
- Radio: As in past years, we will advise local radio stations of the closure and you will be able to hear those reports on the morning radio.

Should the School have to close early during the school day:

- <u>Text</u>: We will text all parents to advise of the closure (as above).
- <u>Website</u>: There will be an update posted on the school website www.swanlandschool.co.uk <u>under Key Info/The School Day and Notices</u>.
- <u>Telephone</u>: Should any children remain uncollected; we will endeavour to telephone any/all of your child's contacts in order for him/her to be collected safely from school.

Where possible, we will endeavour to open the School and will risk assess how many children we can accommodate with staff numbers being taken into consideration. Priority will be given to the children of critical workers in the first instance. Should the School have to be closed for prolonged periods of time, remote learning will be offered via Microsoft Teams so please ensure you know your child's log in details.
