Costumes for 'Robin Hood'

Villagers/Announcer/Narrator/Dancers

Mix and match in browns, beiges and greys: Tunic/top (eg oversized/large, plain, baggy t-shirt) Trousers/leggings/tights/girls may wear long skirt with blouse Rope belt Black sand shoes May carry a draw-string purse (felt or suede) in belt

<u>Outlaws</u>

Mix and match in green and brown (except Will Scarlet - shades of red); Tunic/top (eg oversized/large, plain, baggy t-shirt) Trousers/leggings/tights/girls may wear a long skirt Rope belt Black sand shoes A plastic sword or toy bow and arrow

Guards/Soldiers/Guy of Gisborne/Sheriff of Nottingham/King Richard

Guards and soldiers mix and match black and greys: Guy of Gisborne/Sheriff of Nottingham/King Richard all in black: Tunic/top (eg oversized/large, plain, baggy t-shirt) Trousers/leggings/tights Black leather belt Black sand shoes Plastic sword, shield or helmet NB King Richard — as above plus cloak and crown NB Sheriff of Nottingham — as above plus chains of office

Bishop/Friar Tuck

Ankle-length tunic (eg oversized/large, plain, baggy t-shirt)

- Bishop purple or gold tunic/t-shirt
- Friar Tuck *brown* tunic/t-shirt
- Trousers/leggings/tights

Rope belt

Maid Marion/Marion's Maid/Dancers

Long plain dress NB Maid Marion – as above plus 'Royal' cloak and headdress
