



## Educational Healthcare Plans - What are they? What are the assessments and how to apply.

**Thursday 9 May, 10-11am** - Our Parent Support Group in May is hosted by SENDIASS, a free, impartial and confidential information service for young people with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND).

We understand the process of Educational Healthcare Plans (EHC Plans) can be confusing and also how the assessment process works. The assessment is whereby the Local Authority investigates a child's special educational needs to decide whether any additional support and a EHC plan is required.

We will cover who can apply, and what evidence gets taken into consideration to meet the legal tests for the assessment. Learn more about your options going forward following a refusal to assess decision. The webinar also covers an overview on school SEN support duties for your child during and after this process.

The webinar will be of interest to families and carers of children aged 0-15 with special educational needs and disabilities. It will also be helpful for those wanting to understand the process of getting a EHC plan through an assessment in Hull.
