

Swanland Primary School (part of Edukos Trust) Job Description - Midday Supervisor

The role involves:

- · supervising the children at lunchtimes, both outside and in the classroom if the weather is poor;
- ensuring the children are playing safely;
- · having a clear understanding of safeguarding responsibilities;
- · dealing with minor first aid and referring more serious issues on to the Senior Supervisor as necessary;
- monitoring lunchtimes in the dining hall; assisting the children with their meals if necessary; keeping
 the area safe, clean and free from spills; helping to clear the area at the end of service (this may
 involve some bending, lifting and sweeping);

Uniform and basic health & safety/safeguarding training will be provided.
