Changes to Uniform Policy

From September 2024, there will be a slight change to the school uniform policy. Children will no longer require sandshoes for indoor use. All children should wear black shoes for school. These should be shoes that do not come above the ankle. If you wish your child to travel to school in wellingtons or other types of boots on wet days, they will need to bring school shoes to change in to when they arrive. All children should have a pair of trainers in their PE bag for PE sessions. During the Autumn Term as the weather starts to get more wet, in line with our OPAL work, we will ask every child to bring a pair of wellingtons to keep at school. We are investing in wellington storage through the fund raising we are doing and this will allow children access to our mud kitchens, areas of the field and sand pits all year round.
