Year 2 - Visit to a 1960's Seaside - Thursday 13th June 2024

As part of this term's topic, Year 2 children are having a fun-filled 'Visit to a 1960's Seaside' on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2024, where the children will be discovering how their grandparents and relatives enjoyed days out at the seaside, examining photographs, souvenirs, playing Bingo, tasting wafer ice-creams, learning a ballroom dance, making a windmill, visiting a small beach with a donkey and enjoying a traditional Punch and Judy Show!

This day will also be a non-uniform day for Year 2 children only; they are invited to dress up in shorts and t-shirts or summer dresses (not football kits) and all activities will be taking place at school.

The children will be given a questionnaire to complete along with a Knowledge Organiser (on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May) to assist them to complete an interview with an older family member or friend about seaside trips in 1950/60s. We look forward to receiving these back in.

Over the page is a Consent Form. Please fill it in and return it to your child's class teacher <u>before</u> <u>Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2024</u>. Without a returned Consent Form, your child will be unable to take part in eating ice-cream and rock or visiting the donkey.

A voluntary contribution of £6.34 per child (towards the cost of the Punch and Judy Show, confectionary etc, souvenir bag and a donation towards the R.D.A. in North Ferriby) would be gratefully received. This is now available on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way. As you are now able to give consent on ParentPay you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school. Should you require a paper permission slip, please contact the School Office.

As I am sure you can appreciate, the visit would not be economically viable and, therefore, could not take place should these contributions fail to materialise. However, our policy is that no student should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.
