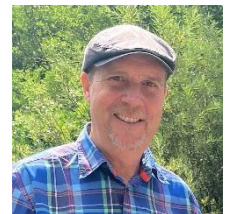


REMINDER: Sponsored Colour Run – Sponsorship monies – LAST DAY
