# <u>Uniform Reminder</u>

From September 2024, there will be a slight change to the school uniform policy. Children will <u>no longer require sandshoes for indoor use</u>. All children should wear black shoes for school. These should be shoes that do not come above the ankle. If you wish your child to travel to school in wellingtons or other types of boots on wet days, they will need to bring school shoes to change in to when they arrive.

<u>All children should have a pair of trainers</u> in their PE bag for PE sessions.

We will be asking <u>every child to bring a pair of wellingtons to keep at school</u> for outdoor play once the weather starts to get wet (we will let Parents know when these need to be brought in).
