Year 2 – ‘Great Fire of London’ Half-Day Workshop on Friday 27th September 2024

In connection with their history topic, the Year 2 children will take part in a ‘Great Fire of London’ event at school on **Friday 27th September 2024**. By participating in this half-day activity, the children will gain historical knowledge and understanding of daily life through first-hand experience.

A costumed member of the living history team, from [History to Life](#), will visit us to run an activity session. The children will learn about the many aspects of The Great Fire of London and the children will rotate around these activities:

- use slate boards to focus on writing and drawing;
- use drawings or words to describe conditions surrounding the fire;
- use dip pens and ink to have a go at writing as Samuel Pepys did;
- teach the children how to draw artefacts from this period.

A voluntary contribution of £4.05 per child to cover the cost of this activity day would be gratefully received. This visit is now available on [ParentPay](#) for you to pay online in the usual way before **Tuesday 17th September 2024**. As you are now able to give consent on [ParentPay](#), you no longer need to return a paper permission slip to school.
