TAILORED LEARNING PATHWAYS

WORKSHOPS/TASTER SESSIONS

These are standalone sessions, and anyone aged 19+ is welcome to join and learn skills in the subject, as well as get a taste of what our longer courses have to offer.

BEGINNERS		
Beginners 1	For those with no experience in the subject, or very basic knowledge	
Beginners 2	For those with basic knowledge who can understand and complete simple tasks	
Beginners 3	For those with increased basic knowledge who are happy working more independently	

INTERMEDIATE		
Intermediate 1	For those with solid basic knowledge who feel confident in completing multi-step tasks and activities. Taking part in discussions and working independently	
Intermediate 2	For those with a sound knowledge in the subject who can complete tasks with only limited support required. You are able to use your skills in a variety of situations.	
Intermediate 3	For learners with a sound knowledge in the subject who can use your skills for personal development and career progression


QUALIFICATIONS

Learners who wish to take a qualification will ideally have taken our beginners and intermediate courses or who have some prior knowledge and experience in the subject. You will have an initial assessment at the start of the course so we can ensure you are studying at the right level.

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POTTERY

Learn practical clay/ceramic skills and techniques which will be embedded through a variety of pottery projects suitable for your level of skill and ability, by creating a number of simple clay pieces.



SEWING



You will learn practical sewing skills and techniques which will be embedded through the creation of simple sewn pieces. Observe tutor demonstrations of the methods and processes of various sewing projects.

This includes using key sewing equipment, learning hand sewing and cutting skills, learning the controls and functions of the sewing machine.

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




SPANISH ES


