Change to School Dinner Menu for Census Day - Thursday 3rd October 2024

Next Thursday is national Census Day for all primary schools, where (amongst other key figures) the number of Key Stage 1 children staying for school dinners that day is recorded. This figure (along with the same figure recorded on the January 2024 Census Day) then determines how much Universal Infant Free School Meal (UIFSM) grant the School receives. This UIFSM grant is paid to the School to cover the cost of the provision of free school meals for our children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 and is paid at the rate of £2.53 per day, throughout the school year, for every child that stays for a meal on those October and January census days (a total of £480.70 per eligible child).



So, with this in mind, we are tweaking the menu next week to encourage as many children as possible to stay for a hot school meal on Thursday. Please see the menu for the day (click here) — Hot Dog (Quorn Sausage for vegetarians), Wedges, Sweetcorn, Garden Peas, and Waffle with Chocolate Sauce for dessert!

May we please ask you to encourage your EYFS/KS1 child to stay for a hot meal that day or to try a hot school meal for the first time, if they have not already done so! Any additional income is very important for the School, so we do hope you can help. Thank you.



Eligibility for Pupil Premium/Free School Meals

Families in receipt of certain <u>state benefits</u> are eligible for Free School Meals, regardless of the child's age. This eligibility for Free School Meals also determines whether the school itself receives the Government's <u>'Pupil Premium'</u> grant, so it is extremely beneficial to the school to be aware of your child's eligibility, <u>even during Reception and Key Stage 1 years</u>.

Your child may be eligible for free school meals if you receive any of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- · the quaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax
 Credit
- · Universal Credit

If you consider that your child MAY be eligible for free school meals in relation to the state benefits which you receive, please complete this online form BEFORE END OF OCTOBER 2024.

If you receive confirmation that your child is eligible for free school meals, we should be very grateful if you would inform the School Office in strictest confidence. Thank you very much.
