Below are a few reminders, such as information about the school day, school lunches, school uniform and attendance. Please do take a little time to read through the items in the letter. Thank you.




#### **Absences**

In order that the school may follow national guidelines, we offer you clear guidance on how you should proceed when your children are either absent or late.

- ALL ABSENCES from school require:
  - A telephone call to the school before 9.15 am on the morning of each day's absence.
     By calling every day, we can be sure of your child's whereabouts and that they are safe.
  - 2. Upon your child's return, written and signed confirmation, explaining the absence, preferably using the school 'Absence Note'. This is available on the school website or from the School Office.
- If your child is going to be LATE, please call the School Office, if possible, to advise and to book a school lunch (if needed).




Reminder of Our School's Food Policy - No Nuts/Peanut Butter or Chocolate Products

Using a laundry marker pen on the label is enough for us to be able to get your child's uniform items back to them, but please check this regularly as it can fade.
