Dear Parent/Carer (Year 3)

Year 3 - Visit to The Deep on Friday 22nd November 2024

It is proposed that the Year 3 children will visit The Deep in Hull on <u>Friday 22nd November 2024</u>. This visit will form part of this term's Science unit 'Animals including Humans'. We will be learning about Food Chains and Predators and Prey. The educational session 'Inspector Sharkey' will complement this. We will also have time to look at the beautiful creatures that live in our oceans.

The children should wear school uniform as usual for the visit but should wear strong walking shoes or trainers. A packed lunch and a drink of water will be required (no glass bottles or plastic food tubs please); please pack this in a disposable bag so it will not need to be carried after lunch. Children who are entitled to free school meals (those families in receipt of certain state benefits, due to financial hardship), may arrange for a packed lunch to be provided for the visit (available upon request).

The children will leave school shortly after registration on the day of the visit and should be back at Swanland Primary School (traffic permitting) by the end of the school day for collection as usual.

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many children as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we are requesting a <u>contribution of £19.67 per child</u>. If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs, then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned.

If you would like your child to attend this visit, you can make your contribution payment by using our secure internet payment site <u>ParentPay</u>. However, our policy is that no child should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

To secure your child's place, £19.67 per child must be received before Thursday 7th November 2024. This is now on the ParentPay website for you to pay online in the usual way.
