Year 5 – Educational Visit to the Hull Guru Nanak Gurdwara Sikh Centre – Wednesday 26th March 2025

As part of Year 5's Religious Education studies, where they are looking at different religions, the children will be visiting Hull Guru Nanak Gurdwara Sikh Centre on the morning of Wednesday 26th March 2025.

The children will travel by coach to the Centre in the morning, where they will learn about some of the religious artefacts, routines and rituals of Sikhi. On the day, the children will be offered food as langar is integral to the Sikhi faith. It will be vegetarian curry with rice and chapattis, biscuits and juice.

We have records of dietary requirements and allergies but if your child is unable to eat any of the above foods, please let us know.

The children will return to school by lunchtime to eat lunch in school as usual.

The children should wear their school uniform for the visit, however, please note legs must be covered. We suggest that if the girls do not have uniform trousers, they wear their PE joggers. Before entering the Centre, everyone will need to cover their head with a bandana, cloth or scarf (if you do not have one of these, the Centre will have extras on hand for visitors). Please note, children will be asked to remove their shoes and wash their hands before entering the Prayer Hall.

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many children as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we are requesting a contribution of £7.00 per child. If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs, then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned.

If you would like your child to attend this visit, you can make your contribution payment by using our secure internet payment site [ParentPay](#). However, our policy is that no child should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

To secure your child's place, £7.00 per child must be received before Thursday 20th March 2025. This is now on the [ParentPay](#) website for you to pay online in the usual way.
