**Year 4 – Visit to the Roman Fort ‘Brigantium’ at Murton Park, York**  
**Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

It is proposed that the Year 4 pupils will visit the Roman Fort ‘Brigantium’ at Murton Park near York on **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2025**. This visit will form part of this year’s continuing history topic on the Romans. Murton Park is an extremely popular venue where the children will spend the day in a replica Roman Fort, experiencing a range of activities which will convey to them the organisation and discipline of the Roman Army.

The children will need to wear warm, old clothes, as they may be involved in messy activities. **A light waterproof and trainers/wellies are essential in case of wet weather.** They may want to wear lots of layers if it is cold and bring a hat and pair of gloves. No watches or jewellery should be worn, as they could easily be lost and difficult to find again.

The children will be leaving school at **9.05 am** and it will, therefore, be necessary for them to **arrive promptly at school at 8.45 am.** They will leave Murton Park in time to arrive back at Swanland Primary School (traffic permitting) no later than **4.00 pm.**

**A packed lunch and a drink of water** are required (no glass bottles please). Children who are entitled to free school meals (those families in receipt of certain state benefits, due to financial hardship), may arrange for a packed lunch to be provided for the visit (available upon request at the school office, **before Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> October.**

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many children as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we are requesting a **contribution of £29.10 per child.** If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs, then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned.
