Year 5 Practical Bikeability Training 2026 – Information and Consent Form



Please find attached information regarding the Year 5 Practical Bikeability Training organised by the East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

This two-day practical course (8 hours in total) will take place between Monday 23rd February and Friday 6th March 2026.

- The first two hours will be delivered on the school playground and will include a basic bicycle safety check.
- The remaining six hours will take place in a live, on-road environment.
- Pupils will be taught in small groups to ensure appropriate supervision and instruction.

If you would like your child to participate in the cycle training programme, please complete the consent form and **return it to your class teacher by Monday 26th January 2026.**

Staffing levels must be arranged in advance by the Road Safety Team and are determined by the number of consent forms received. If a consent form is not returned by the deadline, your child may be unable to take part in the training.
