Each gift costs £6.00. When placing your order, please indicate who the gift is for and whether you have any other children in the school who will also be visiting the shop. This helps us avoid duplicate gifts being selected for the same person.

The deadline for purchasing vouchers is Friday 27th February at 11.00 am. Unfortunately, no late entries can be accepted, as we require sufficient time to source and order the items for the shop.

Please remember to send your child(ren) with their **Mother's Day Shop voucher** on the day, as they will need to hand this in at the shop before choosing their gift. If you are unable to print the voucher, please don't worry – we will have a register of all purchased vouchers available on the day.

This year, the PTA's aim is to continue raising funds for **computing technology** and **outdoor equipment**. A percentage of each gift purchased will contribute directly towards this fund, helping us move closer to our target and ensuring all pupils benefit from these improvements.
