Year 5 – Educational Visit to Hull Guru Nanak Gurdwara Sikh Centre – Wednesday 25th March 2026

As part of Year 5's Religious Education work on world religions, the children will visit the Hull Guru Nanak Gurdwara Sikh Centre on the morning of Wednesday 25th March 2026.

Children will travel by coach and learn about key Sikh artefacts, routines and rituals. They will also be offered vegetarian langar (curry with rice and chapattis) along with biscuits and juice. **We hold dietary and allergy information, but please inform us if your child cannot eat these foods.**

Children will return to school by lunchtime to eat as normal.

Please ensure children wear school uniform with legs covered. If needed, children who usually wear shorts or a skirt to school, may wear their PE joggers. All visitors must cover their heads with a bandana, cloth or scarf (spares are available). Shoes must be removed and hands washed before entering the Prayer Hall.

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits are minimised, so that as many children as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer the visit, we are requesting a contribution of £6.41 per child. If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs, then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned.

If you would like your child to attend this visit, you can make your contribution payment by using our secure internet payment site [ParentPay](#). However, our policy is that no child should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay. Parents in receipt of Income Support or a similar benefit should contact us in the knowledge that the matter will be dealt with in the strictest confidence.

To secure your child's place, £6.41 per child must be received before 10.30 am on Wednesday 11th March 2026. This is now on the [ParentPay](#) website for you to pay online in the usual way.
