**Year 3 – Earthquakes and Volcanoes Day – Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

As part of their science topic, Year 3 will be taking part in an exciting ‘Earthquakes and Volcanoes Day’ at school on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2026. This full-day experience will help the children to deepen their knowledge and understanding of the natural world, with a particular focus on earthquakes and volcanoes. This event will link learning across science, geography and environmental studies, providing a memorable and engaging educational experience for all the children.

One Day Creative will visit the school to deliver a range of engaging workshops, alongside activities led by the Year 3 teaching team. Every day, hundreds of earthquakes occur across the globe—some small, some powerful. During this immersive day, children will explore what earthquakes and volcanoes are, why they happen, and how people can protect themselves from their effects. Throughout the day, children will:

- Explore the key physical geography features of earthquakes and volcanoes
- Learn about significant historical events and current natural disasters
- Discuss how natural disasters could affect their own local area
- Express their ideas and feelings through voice, movement, role play and drama

As a school we work to ensure that the costs of all our visits/events are minimised, so that as many children as possible can take advantage of these valuable learning experiences. In this case, to be able to offer this event, we are requesting a **contribution of £5.16 per child**. If the level of contributions fails to cover the costs, then the visit may be cancelled. Where this happens, all monies will be returned.

However, our policy is that no child should be discriminated against by virtue of their inability to pay.
